# Symphonic Band Syllabus Spring 2020

Welcome to Symphonic Band! I am so excited this year to see us grow as musicians during the spring semester. In this class we will play **3** concert pieces that will challenge us and help us grow as an ensemble in preparation for next fall. In order to have a great marching season we have to have a great concert season! I look forward to working together!

### **Concerts and Festival**

We will have a Spring Concert and we will attend a local concert festival. We are also planning on attending the State Concert Evaluation in April. Attendance is **MANDATORY**. Unless you are sick or there is a family emergency, you are **required** to attend these events.

#### Attendance

You must be **on time** to concert band every day. I will call roll at **1:35** every day. If you are not in your chair when I call roll, you are tardy. There will be consequences for excessive tardiness to band.

## **Disciplinary Plan**

Disrupting rehearsal is **NOT** an option and will not be tolerated. In order to have a successful semester, we have to work together and disrupting rehearsal does not do anything to help our cause.

Here is the plan for disciplinary issues:

1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Verbal Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Conference with Mr. Coile after rehearsal

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense** - Conference with Mr. Coile and Mrs. Pickering after rehearsal. Parents will be notified of excessive disciplinary issues.

If there are multiple disciplinary offenses during the concert season, this may affect your fall semester with the Lewisburg Band.

### **Cell Phones:**

Cell phones are to be placed underneath your chairs everyday while we are in rehearsal. During our scheduled break, you may get on them. During rehearsal, they will be underneath the chairs. If I see you using your phone

or if it is on your stand during rehearsal, I will take it no questions asked. Multiple cell phone offenses will lead to parents being notified as well as conferences with Mr. Coile and Mrs. Pickering

#### **Grades and Due Dates**

The grading policy will follow that of the fall semester. Any pass-off that is not in the email or passed off in person will receive a **one** (1) in the grade book. Any pass-offs that are not completed by the end of the nine weeks will receive a **zero** (0) in the grade book and **WILL NOT** be allowed to be made up. Any late pass-offs will **not receive full credit. We will follow the same late policy as marching season.**

The Pass-Off List for the spring semester will be as follows:

The "Chunk" Exercises from the *Habits* book
All 12 Major Scales (within the chunks)
2-Octave Chromatic Scale

\*\*The other grades will be based on your attendance to the concerts and participation grades\*\*

**Participation grades** will be a 100 a week for being on time and participating during the rehearsal. Any undocumented tardies will be a **5-point** deduction off of your weekly grade. Any undocumented absences will be a **10-point** deduction off your weekly grade. Any disciplinary issues will affect your weekly participation grade as well.

All "Chunks" will be performed out of the *Habits of a Successful Musician* book. They will be played at a minimum Metronomic Marking of 60 bpm.

If you record your pass-off, I MUST be able to hear the metronome in the recording. If I do not hear the metronome, it will not count! If you do not play in time with the metronome it will not count.

### \*\*\*YOU MAY USE YOUR BOOK FOR PASS-OFFS \*\*\*

In the Gradebook, pass-offs will be labeled as the date they are due. If everything is not passed off for that date, it does not count. If there are multiple pass-offs on a date, they will be averaged together for that date's grade
